HEEL SWIVELS TO LEFT & RIGHT

Count: 46

- 1-4 Swivel heels to left, swivel toes to left, swivel heels to left, swivel toes to left
- 5-8 Swivel toes to right, swivel heels to right, swivel toes to right, swivel heels to right

FORWARD STRUTS, RIGHT KICKS, RIGHT BACK, TOUCH LEFT BACK

- 9-12 Step right toe forward, step down on heel, step left toe forward, step down on heel
- 13-16 Kick right forward, kick right forward, step right back, touch left back

FORWARD STEP, SINGLE SCOOT, TWO TRIPLES FORWARD, STEP, ½ TURN

- Step left forward, scoot left forward with right knee hitched 17-18
- 19&20, 21&22 Triple forward right, left, right, triple forward left, right, left
- 23-24 Step right forward, on balls of both feet pivot 1/2 turn to left, weight on left

TWO TRIPLES FORWARD, TWO SCOOTS FORWARD

- 25&26,27&28 Triple forward right, left, right, triple forward left, right, left
- Scoot forward on left with right knee hitched, scoot forward on left with right knee hitched 29-30

VINE TO RIGHT WITH FORWARD AND SIDE TOUCHES

31-36 Step right foot to right, step left foot behind right, step right foot to right. Touch left forward, touch left to left. Clap

VINE TO LEFT WITH FORWARD AND SIDE TOUCHES

37-42 Step left foot to left, step right foot behind left, step right foot to left. Touch right forward, touch right to right, clap

STEP FORWARD, LOCK STEP, ¼ TURN, STOMP

43-46 Step right forward, lock step left by right, step right forward making ¼ turn to right, stomp left next to right

Start over.

This dance was originally choreographed by Ruth Elias as "Johnny O" with 42 counts and her dance was done to Johnny O by the Nitty Gritty Dirt Band and to Badly Bent by the Tractors.

In 1991 someone added two counts to the right vine making it 6 counts, and 2 counts to the left vine also making it 6 counts and called the resulting 46 count dance "Boot Scootin' Boogie".

This 46 count version of her dance is the one commonly done in Georgia and Alabama to the song Boot Scootin' Boogie by Brooks and Dunn.
