[1-8] TAP, &, TAP, &, FORWARD, TAP, BACK, LOCK, BACK, ROCK, RECOVER:

1&2&	Right heel tap forward; (&) Right step to center; Left heel tap forward; (&) Left step to center
------	--

3 - 4 Right forward; Tap Left toe behind right

5 & 6 Left step back; Right cross slightly over left; Left step back

7 - 8 Rock back Right; Recover forward Left

[9-16] TRIPLE 1/2 TURN, ROCK, RECOVER, TRIPLE 1/2 TURN, ROCK, RECOVER:

1 & 2	Turn 1/4 left stepping side Right; Left step next to right; Turn 1/4 left stepping back right
-------	---

3 - 4 Left rock back; Right recover

5 & 6 Turn 1/4 right stepping side Left; Right step next to left; Turn 1/4 right stepping back Left

7 - 8 Right rock back; Left recover (12:00)

*Restart here during wall 5 (12:00) after guitar instrumentals

[17-24] KICK, BALL, CHANGE, TRIPLE, FORWARD, 1/4 TURN, CROSS, &, CROSS:

1 & 2	Right kick forward; Right step next to left; Left forward
3 & 4	Right forward; Left next to right; Right forward
5 - 6	Left forward; Turn 1/4 right stepping side right
7 & 8	Left cross over right; Right side right; Left cross over right (3:00)

[25-32] SIDE, HOLD, &, SIDE, TOGETHER, 1/2 MONTEREY TURN:

1-2-&	Right side right; (2) HOLD; (&) Left step next to right
3 - 4	Right side right; Left step together next to right
5 - 6	Right point side right; Bring Right next to left as you turn 1/2 right (weight is right)
7 - 8	Left point side left; Left step next to right (9:00)

BEGIN AGAIN!

*ENDING: When you are at the 3:00 wall for the 3rd time, change the 1/2 Monterey (ct. 6) into a *3/4 Monterey to face 12:00 and point Left to the side (ct. 7)

*CHRISTMAS SONG: Rockin' Around the Christmas Tree by Toby Keith - A Classic Christmas album Start on vocals (no restart when using this Christmas tune)
