[9-16] L side, R together, L back shuffle, $1 / 2 R, R$ fwd shuffle, L fwd, $1 / 4$ R pivot turn
1-2 Step $L$ side, step $R$ together
3\&4 Step L back, step $R$ together, step $L$ back
5\&6 Turning $1 / 2$ right step $R$ forward, step $L$ together, step $R$ forward ( 6 o'clock)
7-8 Step L forward, pivot $1 / 4$ right ( 9 o'clock)
TAGS: DURING WALLS $3 \& 6$ dance the first 14 counts and then do the following 2 count tag:

3\&4 Cross step $L$ behind $R$, step $R$ side, cross step $L$ over $R$
5-6 Rock $R$ side, recover weight on $L$
7\&8 Cross step $R$ behind $L$, step $L$ to left, step $R$ to right.
[25-32] L cross rock/recover, $1 / 4 L$ toaster step (turning coaster), $R$ fwd, $1 / 4 L$ pivot turn, $R$ cross shuffle
1-2 $\quad L$ cross rock, recover weight on $R$
3\&4 Turning $1 / 4$ left step $L$ back, step $R$ together, step $L$ forward ( 6 o'clock)
5-6 Step $R$ forward, pivot $1 / 4$ left (3 o'clock)
7\&8 Cross step R over L, step L side, cross step R over L
