Intro: 16 counts

## **SIDE, TOGETHER, SHUFFLE FORWARD, STEP ¼ TURN LEFT, STEP RIGHT TO SIDE, CROSSING SHUFFLE**

- 1,2,3&4      Step right to right side, step left next to right, shuffle forward right, left, right  
5,6,7&8      Step left forward turning slightly left, step right to right side, cross left over right, step right to side, cross left over right

## **Man: WALK, WALK, SHUFFLE, WALK, WALK SHUFFLE**

## **Lady: ¼ TURN, ½ TURN, SHUFFLE BACK, ¼ TURN, ¼ TURN, SHUFFLE FORWARD**

- 1,2,3&4      MAN: Turn ¼ to LOD walk forward right, left, shuffle right, left, right  
                 Lady: Turn ¼ turn right step forward on right, ½ turn right stepping back on left, shuffle back right, left, right (RLOD)  
5,6,7&8      Man: Walk left, right, shuffle left, right, left  
                 Lady: Turn ¼ right step back on left, turn ¼ turn right step forward on right, shuffle forward left, right, left (LOD)

## **MAN: ROCKING CHAIR X 2**

## **LADY: ½ PIVOT, ROCKING CHAIR, ½ PIVOT**

- 1,2,3,4      Man: Rock forward on right, recover on left, rock forward on right, recover on left  
                 Lady: Step forward on right, pivot ½ turn left stepping on left, rock forward on right, recover to left  
5,6,7,8      Man: Rock forward on right, recover on left, rock forward on right, recover on left  
                 Lady: Rock back on right, recover to left, step forward right, pivot ½ turn left weight to left

## **DIAGONAL FORWARD, ROCK RECOVER, LEFT DIAGONAL STEP, ROCK, RECOVER**

- 1,2,3,4      Step right to right diagonal, rock forward on left, recover to right, squaring up to LOD step left to side  
5,6,7,8      Step right to left diagonal, rock forward on left, recover to right, squaring up to LOD step back on left
