**Position: Man behind lady in Indian position**

## **ROCK LEFT RIGHT CHA-CHA-CHA, ROCK RIGHT LEFT CHA-CHA-CHA**

- 1-2 Left rock forward, hands over lady's shoulders, rock back in place on right foot
- 3&4 Cha-cha in place left, right, left
- 5-6 Right rock back, rock in place on left
- 7&8 Cha-cha in place right, left, right

## **STEP PIVOT CHA-CHA-CHA**

**Man & lady face RLOD in Reverse Indian Position**

- 9 Step left forward
- Take left hands over lady's head**
- 10 Pivot half turn right with man behind lady
- Drop right hands and rejoin behind**
- 11&12 Cha-cha in place left, right, left

**Man's back at waist level**

## **ROCK FORWARD, BACK, CHA-CHA, STEP PIVOT, CHA-CHA-CHA**

- 13-14 Right rock forward, left rock back
- 15&16 Cha-cha in place right, left, right
- 17-18 Left rock back, right rock forward
- 19&20 Cha-cha in place left, right, left

## **STEP PIVOT CHA-CHA-CHA**

**Man move to left into Sweetheart Position**

- 21-22 Step right forward, pivot half turn
- 23&24 Cha-cha in place right, left, right

## **HEEL TOE CHA-CHA-CHA X 4**

- 25-26 Left heel touch forward, left toe touch floor across right
- 27&28 Cha-cha left, right, left moving forward
- 29-30 Right heel touch forward, right toe touch floor across left
- 31&32 Cha-cha right, left, right moving forward
  
- 33-40 Repeat steps 25-32

## **STEP LOCK CHA-CHA-CHA, STEP LOCK CHA-CHA-CHA**

- 41-42 Left step forward diagonally, right lock behind left
- 43&44 Cha-cha left, right, left
- 45-46 Right step forward diagonally, left lock behind right
- 47&48 Cha-cha right, left, right

## **LEFT GRAPEVINE, RIGHT GRAPEVINE**

- 49-50 Left step to left, right cross behind left
- 51&52 Cha-cha left, right, left
- 53-54 Right step to right, left cross behind right
- 55&56 Cha-cha right, left, right

**Man moves behind lady into Indian Position**

**REPEAT**
