S1: Side,Behind $\frac{1}{4}$ $\frac{1}{4}$ Rock, Replace Side, Behind $\frac{1}{4}$ Rock Replace, $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{4}$

1,2& Slide Step R to R, Cross L behind R, $\frac{1}{4}$ R step on R □ □ □ □ 3
3,4& $\frac{1}{4}$ R step L to L side, Rock R behind L, Replace on L □ □ □ □ 6
5,6& Step R to R, Cross L behind R, $\frac{1}{4}$ R step on R □ □ □ □ 9
7,8& Rock forward on L, Recover on R, $\frac{1}{2}$ L step on L □ □ □ □ 3

S2: $\frac{1}{4}$, Sailor $\frac{1}{2}$, Side Cross Side, Rock $\frac{1}{4}$ L, Step $\frac{3}{4}$ L

1,2&3 $\frac{1}{4}$ Slide R to R, Sailor $\frac{1}{2}$ L, cross L over R on count 3 (6)
*** W/8
4&5 Step R to R, Cross L over R, Step R to R □ □ □ □ □ 6
6&7 Rock L over R, Recover on R, $\frac{1}{4}$ L step on L □ □ □ □ □ 9
8&1 Step on R, Pivot $\frac{3}{4}$ L, Slide Step out on R □ □ □ □ □ 6

S3: Rock Replace Side, Behind Side Cross, Side Rock Cross, Extended Cross Shuffle, Rock

2&3 Rock L behind R, Recover on R, Step L to L □ □ □ □ □ 6
4&5 Cross R behind L, Step L to L, Cross R over L (6)
*** W/5 □
6&7 Rock L out to L, Recover on R, Cross L over R □ □ □ □ □ 6
8&8&1 Step R to R, Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross rock L over R □ □ □ □ 7

S4: Back R.L.R,Forward Shuffle, Back Shuffle, Side Tap

2&3 Run back R.L.R □ □ □ □ □ □ □ 7
4&5 Diagonal shuffle forward L.R.L □ □ □ □ □ □ 5
6&7 Shuffle back diagonal R.L.R □ (straighten up to 3) □ □ □ □ 3
8& Step L to L, Touch R toe to L □ □ □ □ □ □ 3

*** Restart & Change of step on Wall 5.

Dance up to and including count 4& on section 3, change count 5 push off on L taking along step to the R starting the dance again from count 1. □

*** Restart on Wall 8.

Dance up to and including count 1 on section 2, then Restart the dance agsin from count 1. □ □ □

NB: It's nice to accentuate the steps to coincide with the music, using the NC2 style of slide steps putting your own interpretation into the song.
