Indian man behind woman facing outside line of dance hands at shoulder height Same Foot work throughout.

Side rock recover twice, rumba box

- 12& Step right, rock back left recover right
- 34& Step left rock back right recover left
- 5&6 right side left together forward right
- left side right together back left 7&8

Side shuffle right, sailor guarter right-lock step forward twice

- 1&2 right side together join left to right step left side
- 3&4 left foot behind, quarter turn left right step left slightly side.

(Arms Into Sweetheart)

- 5&6 forward right, lock left behind right forward left.
- 7&8 forward left, lock right behind left forward right.

Step guarter pivot left cross, rock recover cross, 8 count weave

step forward right, quarter pivot left, cross right over left 1&2

- (Bring Right Arm Over The Top Of Ladies Head Into Reverse Indian)
- 3&4 rock left side, recover onto right, cross left over right
- 5&6& step side right, cross left behind right, step right side, cross left over right
- 7&8& step side right, cross left behind right, step right side, cross left over right

Side recover cross, rock quarter turn right step, lock step forward, step quarter pivot right cross.

- 1&2 rock right to side recover left cross right in front of left
- 3&4 rock left to side recover onto right as your quarter turn right step forward left (bring arms back to sweetheat)
- 5&6 step forward right lock left behind right step forward right
- step forward left quarter turn right cross left over right. 7&8

(Return to Indian keeping hands at shoulder level)

Start again and enjoy.
