5-8 L Heel, Toe (weight on right)
S2: L FORWARD STEP TOGETHER STEP HOLD, R HEEL TOE
1-4 L Step Forward, R Next to L, L Step Forward, Hold
5-8 $\quad R$ Heel, Toe (weight on left)
S3: R SIDE STEP TOGETHER STEP HOLD, SWAY
1-4 $\quad$ Step to Right Side, L Next to R, R Step to Right Side, Hold
5-8 Sway
S4: L SIDE STEP TOGETHER STEP HOLD, SWAY
1-4 L Step to Left Side, R Next to L, L Step to Left Side, Hold
5-8 Sway
S5: 1/2 TURN RIGHT WALK R,L,R,L,
1-8 Turn $1 / 2$ Right with Walks R,L,R,L
Fun Fact: Clyde McPhatter formed the group "Drifters". "A Lover's Question" was the most successful in his solo career. Elvis Presley recorded several of his songs.
