The PV in the title refers to Puerto Vallarta, Mexico, where the dance was written. Brittany Kingery currently resides and performs in Puerto Vallarta.

Intro: 26 counts (Start on vocals)

[1-8]□Cross Rock L over R, Recover on R, Triple-Step to L, Cross Rock R over L, Recover on L, Triple-Step to R

1-2,3&4 Cross rock L over R, Rec on R, Triple-Step (L,R,L) to L 5-6,7&8 Cross rock R over L, Rec on L, Triple-Step (R,L,R) to R

[9-16] ☐ Step L over R, Step R, Turn ¼ to L and Triple-Step to L, Weave with ¼ turn to L

1-2,3&4 Step L over R, Step R, Turn ¼ to L and Triple-Step (L,R,L) to L

5-6-7-8 Step R over L, Step L, Step R behind L, Turn ¼ to L and step forward on L (6:00)

[17-24]□Rock Forward R, Recover on L, Triple-Step Back, Rock Back on L, Recover on R, Triple-Step Forward

1-2,3&4 Rock forward on R, Rec on L, Triple-Step back (R,L,R) 5-6,7&8 Rock back on L, Rec on R, Triple-Step forward (L,R,L)

[25-32]□¼ Turns to L X 3, Coaster Step

Step forward on R, Turn ¼ to L and step on L (3:00)
Step forward on R, Turn ¼ to L and step on L (12:00)
Step forward on R, Turn ¼ to L and step on L (9:00)
Step back on R, Step L beside R, Step forward on R

(coaster step can be done on the diagonal so that the cross rock on the new start is easier)
