[17-24] SAMBA WALKS

1&2, 3&4 Step L Fwd, Ball Step R Behind L, Step L in Place, Step R Fwd, Ball Step L Behind R, Step R

in place

5&6, 7&8 Step L Fwd, Ball Step R Behind L, Step L in Place, Step R Fwd, Ball Step L Behind R, Step R

in place

[25-32] VOLTA TO R, 1/2 Turn, VOLTA TO L

1&2&3&4& Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross

L over R, Step R to R, without moving feet twist ½ turn to R

5&6&7&8 Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross L over R, Step R to R, Cross

L over R, Step R to R
