Intro: 16 counts, start on vocals (for 'Save It For A Sunny Day')

Intro: 32 counts, start on vocals (for 'If You Love Her')

SIDE, TOGETHER, CROSS SHUFFLE, ¾ TURN LEFT, COASTER

- 1, 2 Step R to side, step L next to R (12:00)
- 3&4 Cross R over L, step L slightly left, cross R over L
- 5, 6 Turn ¼ left stepping L fwd, turn ½ left stepping R back (3:00)
- 7&8 Step L back, step R next to L, step L fwd

FWD, TOUCH, BACK SHUFFLE, ½ TURNING SHUFFLE, ¼ SIDE SHUFFLE

- 1, 2 Step R fwd, tap L next to R
- 3&4 Step L back, step R next to L, step L back
- 5&6 Turn ¼ right stepping R to side, step L next to R, turn ¼ right stepping R fwd (9:00)
- 7&8 Turn ¼ right stepping L to side, step R next to L, step L to side (12:00)

(Note: Shuffle counts 3-8 travel slightly using hips)

BEHIND, ¼, ¼ PIVOT, CROSS, RONDE SWEEP, CROSS, SIDE

- 1, 2 Step R behind L, turn ¼ left stepping L fwd (9:00)
- 3, 4 Step R fwd, pivot ¼ turn left transferring weight onto L (6:00)
- 5, 6 Cross R over L, ronde sweep L from back to front
- 7, 8 Cross L over R, step R to side

BEHIND, RONDE SWEEP, BEHIND, ¼, FWD, SPIRAL TURN LEFT, FWD LOCK SHUFFLE

- 1, 2 Cross L behind R, ronde sweep R from front to back
- 3, 4 Cross R behind L, turn ¼ left stepping L fwd (3:00)
- 5, 6 Step R fwd, make a full turn to the left drawing L foot across R shin on the turn,
- 7&8 Step L fwd, step R behind L, step L fwd

For 'Save It For A Sunny Day' – no restart.

For 'If You Love Her', * RESTART: on wall 6 after 8 counts (facing 6:00).

For 'Save It For A Sunny Day', * ENDING: on last wall, dance up to 5 counts, turn ¼ left stepping R to side, to face the front.

For 'If You Love Her', * * ENDING: on last wall, instead of full Spiral Turn left, make a ¾ Spiral Turn left, to face the front.
