**Wall:** 2

**Level:** Absolute Beginner

**Choreographer:** R and R Line Dancing (USA) - July 2025

**Music:** Til A Mawnin (feat. Sting) - Shaggy



**Begin the dance on Sting's vocals 32 Counts**

**No tags and no restarts**

**(1-8) Step Touch, Side Steps**

1,2,3,4            Step R Touch L Step L Touch R

5,6,7,8            Step R Side Step, Step L Next to R, Step R Side Step, Touch L next to R

**(9-16) Step Touch, Side Steps**

1,2,3,4            Step L Touch R, Step R Touch L

5,6,7,8            Step L Side Step, R next to L, Step L Side Step, Touch R next to L

**Styling Option:**

**Add claps at shoulder height on the step touches**

**(17-24) Heel Kicks x2, ¼ Turns x2**

1,2,3,4            R Heel out, R next to L, L Heel out L next to R

5,6,7,8            Step R Forward, ¼ Turn L, Step R Forward, ¼ Turn L

**Styling Option: Roll Hips as you make the turn, slightly bending in the knees**

**(25-32) Cross Points, Jazz Box**

1,2,3,4            Cross R over L, Point L, Cross L over R, Point R

5,6,7,8            Cross R over L, Back Step L, Step R Next to L, Step L

**The rhythm of reggae music allows for plenty of opportunities to add you own personal flair to this dance.**
