16 count intro - NO TAGS OR RESTARTS

Heel Strut Fwd RL, Fwd Back Back Fwd

1,2,3,4 Heel strut fwd R,L
5,6,7,8 Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L, Rock/step back on R, Rock fwd on L

Heel Fwd Back, Heel Strut, Step Pivot 1/4, Stomp Hold

9,10,11,12 Touch R heel fwd, Touch R toe back, Heel strut fwd on R
13,14 Step fwd on L, Pivot 1/4 right transferring wt to R
15,16 Stomp L beside R, Hold

Vine Right Step Across, 1/4 Monterey

17,18,19,20 Step R to right, Step L behind R, Step R to right, Step L across R
21,22,23,24 Touch R toe right, Making 1/4 right step R beside L, Touch L to left, Step L beside R

Toe Strut Back R,L, Step Back Together, Twist Heels Right Centre

25,26,27,28 Toe strut back R ,L
29,30,31,32 Step back on R, Step L beside R, Twist heels right, Twist heels to centre (wt on L)

Side Behind Side Hold, Behind Side Cross Rock Replace

33,34,35,36 Step R to right, Step L behind R, Step R to right, Hold
37,38,39,40 Step L behind R, Step R to right, Cross/rock L over R, Replace wt back onto R

Side Together, 1/4 Fwd Scuff, Step Hitch/clap, Step Hitch/clap

41,42,43,44 Step L to left, Step R beside L, Making 1/4 left step fwd on L, Scuff R fwd
45,46,47,48 Step fwd on R, Hop/Hitch L and clap, Step fwd on L, Hop/Hitch R and clap

Side Together Back Hitch, 1/4 Turn Together, Fwd Scuff

49,50,51,52 Step R to right, Step L beside R, Step back on R, Hitch L
53,54,55,56 Making 1/4 left step L to left side, Step R beside L, Step fwd on L, Scuff R fwd

Fwd Back, Back Hitch, 1/2 Fwd Lock Behind, Step Fwd Scuff

57,58 Rock/step fwd on R, Rock back on L
59,60 Step back on R, Hook L across R while starting 1/2 left
61,62,63,64 Completing 1/2 turn step fwd on L, Lock/step R behind L, Step fwd on L, Scuff R fwd

This is a good uptempo song by Travis Collins that is easy to dance to.!
