1&2 3&4 Shuffle forward right left right, left right left

Rock up on right, rock back on left
Rock back right left right, left right left
Rock back on right, recover on left

Step forward on right making half pivot turn to left landing on left Step forward on right making half pivot turn to left landing on left

QUARTER PIVOT LEFT TURN DOING GRAPEVINES TO RIGHT, LEFT

1 2 3 4 Making quarter left turn pivot on right foot doing grapevine right, left, right, left

5 6 7 8 Do left grapevine left, right, left right

TLC'S TO RIGHT, LEFT SLOW SLOW QUICK QUICK

Step to right, touch left to rightStep to left, touch right to left

5 6 7 8 With feet apart rock right, left, right, left
