#### 24 count intro.

#### Waltz Back 1/4, Step Fwd Slide Hold

- Step back on R, Step L beside R as you make 1/4 turn left, Step R beside L 1.2.3
- 4.5.6 Step fwd on L, Slide R to left, Hold

#### Waltz Back 1/4, Step Fwd Slide Hold

- 7.8.9 Step back on R, Step L beside R as you make 1/4 turn left, Step R beside L
- 10,11,12 Step fwd on L, Slide R to left, Hold

## Waltz Back 1/2 Turn, Waltz Fwd 1/2 Turn

- 13,14,15 Waltz back R,L,R as you make 1/2 turn left
- 16,17,18 Waltz fwd L,R,L as you make 1/2 turn left

## Waltz Back, Step Fwd Slide Hold

- 19,20,21 Waltz back R,L,R
- 22,23,24 Step fwd on L, Slide R to L, Hold

## Step Back Heel Fwd, Step Fwd, Touch Beside, Step Back, Heel Fwd

- 25,26,27 Step back on R, Touch L heel fwd, Step fwd on L
- 28,29,30 Touch R beside L, Step back on R, Touch L heel fwd

## Step Fwd Scuff Fwd Back, Step Back 1/4 Touch Hold

- 31,32,33 Step fwd on L, Scuff R fwd, Scuff R back
- 34,35,36 Step back on R, Making 1/4 left touch L beside R, Hold

## Waltz Fwd 1/2 Turn, Waltz Back 1/4 Turn

- 37,38,39 Waltz fwd L,R,L while making 1/2 turn left
- 40,41,42 Waltz back R,L,R while making 1/4 turn left

## Step fwd Touch Hold, Step Right Touch, Step Beside

43,44,45 Step fwd on L, Touch R beside L, Hold 46,47,48 Step R to right, Touch L beside R, Step L beside R (wt now on L)

\* This dance has 9 walls and finishes facing the back. To finish facing the front do this.... At count 35-36 leave out the 1/4 turn. Then waltz fwd with 1/2 turn, waltz back. Finish facing the front with counts 43-48
