S2: Forward rock. Shuffle back x 2. Back rock

5&6	Step back on Left. Step Right beside Left. Step back on Left

7 – 8 Rock back on Right. Recover onto Left

S3: Step. Pivot quarter turn Left. Shuffle forward. Step. Pivot half turn Right. Shuffle forward

1 – 2	Step forward on Right. Pivot quarter turn Left
3&4	Step forward on Right. Step Left beside Right. Step forward on Right
5 – 6	Step forward on Left. Pivot half turn Right (Facing 3 o'clock)
7&8	Step forward on Left. Step Right beside Left. Step forward on Left

S4: Jazz box with cross. Chasse Right. Back rock

1 – 2	Cross Right over Left. Step back on Left
3 – 4	Step Right to Right side. Cross Left over Right
5&6	Step Right to Right side. Step Left beside Right. Step Right to Right side
7 – 8	Rock back on Left. Recover onto Right

S5: Vine Left. Cross. Chasse Left. Back rock

1 – 2	Step Left to Left side. Cross Right behind Left
3 – 4	Step Left to Left side. Cross Right over Left
5&6	Step Left to Left side. Step Right beside Left. Step Left to Left side
7 – 8	Rock back on Right. Recover onto Left

S6: Monterey quarter turn Right. Heel switches x 3. Clap twice

3 – 4	Touch Left toe to Left side. Step Left beside Right
5&6&	Touch Right heel forward. Step Right beside Left. Touch Left heel forward. Step Left beside
