**Position: Start in Sweetheart position. Steps for both partners are the same**

## **ROCK, RECOVER, SHUFFLE ½ TURN RIGHT, ROCK, RECOVER, SHUFFLE ½ TURN LEFT**

1-2              Rock forward on right, recover weight onto left  
3&4              Shuffle ½ turn right with right, left, right  
5-6              Rock forward on left, recover weight onto right  
7&8              Shuffle ½ turn left with left, right, left

## **FULL TURN LEFT, SHUFFLE FORWARD RIGHT, FULL TURN RIGHT, SHUFFLE FORWARD LEFT**

**Drop right hand:**

9-10              On ball of left ½ turn left stepping back on right, make ½ turn left stepping forward on left  
11&12              Shuffle forward with right, left, right

**Change hand from left to right (in front of lady)**

13-14              On ball of right ½ turn right stepping back on left, make ½ turn right stepping forward on right

**Come back into Sweetheart Position**

15&16              Shuffle forward with left, right, left

## **½ PIVOT TURN LEFT TWICE, JAZZ BOX WITH ¼ TURN RIGHT**

**Drop right hand**

17-18              Step forward right, pivot ½ turn left  
19-20              Step forward right, pivot ½ turn left

**Come back into Sweetheart Position**

21-22              Step right across left, step back on left  
23-24              Make ¼ right stepping right to side, step left slightly to left side

## **CROSS BEHIND, ¼ TURN LEFT, STEP, ½ PIVOT TURN LEFT, STEP, ½ PIVOT TURN LEFT, STEP, TOGETHER**

25-26              Cross right behind left, make ¼ turn left stepping forward on left

**Drop right hand**

27-28              Step forward on right, pivot ½ turn left  
29                  Step forward on right

**Change hand from right to left (in front of lady)**

30-31              Step forward on left, pivot ½ turn right

**Come back into Sweetheart Position**

32                  Step forward on left

**REPEAT**

The changes of hands are always done in front and not too close to the lady's face.
