ALTERNATE MUSIC

COUNTRY: Use the Shania Twain music. We favor the "Live From Vegas" version.

ROCK: We suggest "Crocodile Rock" by Elton John (4:13,150 BPM). 32 Count intro. Try the live track from

"One Night Only: Live Greatest Hits". And sing along in the appropriate spots! HALLOWEEN: Short Tag end of Wall #8. Music, Demos and Stepsheet at https://www.copperknob.co.uk/stepsheets/spooky-scary-skeletons-ID137065.aspx

S1: DIAGONAL STEP-TOUCH FORWARD X2, DIAGONAL STEP-TOUCH BACKWARD X2

Step RF forward on right diagonal (1), touch LF beside RF (2)
Step LF forward on left diagonal (3), touch RF beside LF (4)
Step RF back on right diagonal (5), touch LF beside RF (6)
Step LF back on left diagonal (7), touch RF beside LF (8)

S2: CHASSE RIGHT, CHASSE LEFT (OPTIONAL ARMS OUT-IN-OUT-IN)

Step RF to right (2), step LF beside RF (2), step RF to right (3), touch LF beside RF (4)
Step LF to left (5), step RF beside LF (6), step LF to left (7), touch RF beside LF (8)

S3: ROCKING CHAIR, JAZZ 1/4 TURN RIGHT (3:00)

1234 Rock RF forward (1), recover weight to LF (2), rock RF back (3), recover weight to LF (4)

Step RF across LF (5), step back with LF making ¼ turn right (6) (3:00)

78 Step RF to right side (7), step LF beside RF (8)

S4: LONG SIDE-TOUCHES WITH HOLD X2 (OPTIONAL SHIMMIES)

Long step RF to right side (1), hold (2), touch LF beside RF (3), hold (4) Long step LF to left side (5), hold (6), touch RF beside LF (3), hold (4)
